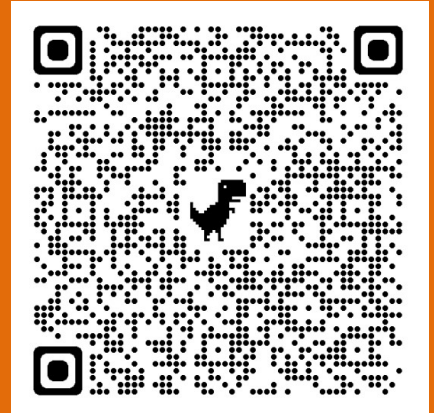
February 22: Ash Wednesday: a day of prayer and fasting that begins the Christian season of Lent
